

Secondary Student Contract

As a student sponsored by the Chippewas of the Thames Board of Education, I agree to and accept the following conditions and responsibilities:

1. I will take my secondary school education seriously.
2. I will attend school on a daily basis and attend all classes when I am at school. I will telephone in if I am absent from school, and provide a signed note from my parent/guardian explaining my absence.
3. I agree that attendance is important and that late arrivals will not be tolerated.
4. I will be prepared for class, have assigned work completed, submit lessons as required, and be prepared for tests and examinations.
5. I will seek support from the guidance department at the secondary school to review my educational plan.
6. I will show respect and honour when interacting within the school community and behave in an appropriate manner to all staff and students.
7. I will review and abide by the [Safe Schools Act](#) and I will not engage in any violent activities at school or on school buses.

Failure to comply with the above conditions will warrant a referral to the Rebound Program and a Peer Mentoring Circle administered in partnership by the Chippewas of the Thames Youth Justice Program and the Chippewas of the Thames First Nation Board of Education.

Breach of this contract may jeopardize and/or result in the cancellation of my educational sponsorship with Chippewas of the Thames First Nation Board of Education.

My contract will be reviewed on a weekly basis. If I am not adhering to the above contract, I understand that I may be exited from school.

Board of Education School Bus Riding Rules and Regulations

Student's Code of Behaviour

I WILL

- a) Enter the bus and take my (assigned) seat in an orderly manner.
- b) Remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- c) Always keep my head and arms inside the bus.
- d) Talk quietly and no unnecessary noises.
- e) Not throw anything from the bus.
- f) Not smoke, eat, or use profane language while on the bus.
- g) Not to bring any medication on the bus.
- h) Not fight or horseplay on the bus.
- i) Not refuse another student a seat on the bus.

**A note is required from the parents/guardians for a student to get off the bus at any place other than their residence.

STUDENTS NOT OBEYING THE CODE OF BEHAVIOUR WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE BY THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL/DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, AS PER THE SCHOOL DISCIPLINE POLICY. Which may result is a referral to the Rebound Program and a Peer Mentoring Circle administered in partnership by Chippewas of the Thames youth Justice Program and the Chippewas of the Thames Board of Education.
